

Winter Snowscape!

Physical Skills



Rip, tear, cut, fold and roll pieces of paper to make a winter snowscape. What kind of snowy day is it? Imagine it's **calm**. Then imagine there's a heavy snow storm, a **whirling snowstorm** like that in the story 'We're going on a Bear Hunt.' Now move your bits of paper to make a moving image.

Tools

Cut out little shapes and strips from **cotton wool**, **magazines** and **Christmas cards**. Stick these bits together with **glue** to make some winter pictures such as a snow person or snow monster!

Colourful Ice Sculpture!



Investigate

Freeze water to make some ice. Take a **paintbrush** or **stick** to dribble diluted **food colouring** into the ice. Add **salt** too which lowers the temperature of the ice. The ice should **melt** more easily encouraging the **different colours** to mix as they slowly run and swirl. If you don't have food colouring, you can just add salt to see what happens!

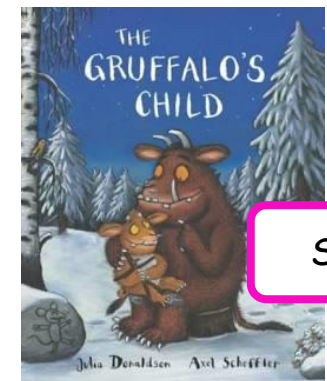
